

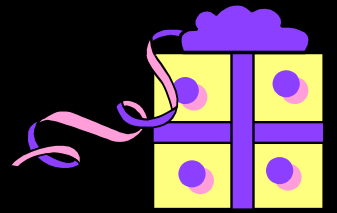
# Thesis:
